A member of the Board of Trustees of South Texas College may be removed from office for incompetency, official misconduct, or other grounds provided by law as specified in Article V, Section 24 of the Texas Constitution Government Code §§87.011, 87.012, 87.013, 87.031, and Education Code § 44.032(3e) and 130.0845.

A member of the Board of Trustees of the South Texas College may be also removed from office, under Texas Education Code §130.0845, if the member is absent from more than half of the regularly scheduled Board meetings that the member is eligible to attend during a calendar year, not counting an absence for which the member is excused by a majority vote of the Board.

Removal of a Member of the Board of Trustees must be conducted in accordance with procedures provided by Subchapter B, Chapter 87, Local Government Code, for removing a county official.
