To provide an effective learning environment, the College affirms that it shall do the following:

1. Acknowledge its obligation to provide for the safety of students, faculty, and staff in all College related matters, whether on or off campus.
2. Provide student conduct and discipline procedures that are clearly stated and rationally related to the goal of providing an effective environment for students to learn and for faculty to teach. The student conduct and discipline procedures are detailed in the Student Code of Conduct and include the following elements:
 - a. A statement of purpose for the procedures;
 - b. A partial list of actions, whether committed on or off campus, which will render a student subject to disciplinary action;
 - c. A list of authorized disciplinary actions that may be imposed upon a student;
 - d. A detailed statement of clearly defined procedures which will be followed when a student is alleged to have violated campus regulations.
3. Actively pursue legal action and cooperate with law enforcement authorities in the investigation and prosecution for actions by students and non-students that violate federal, state or local criminal laws and initiate appropriate civil litigation for the recovery of damages or actions that occur on the campus, extended facilities, or during a college related activity.
4. Procedures are readily available in the Student Handbook.
